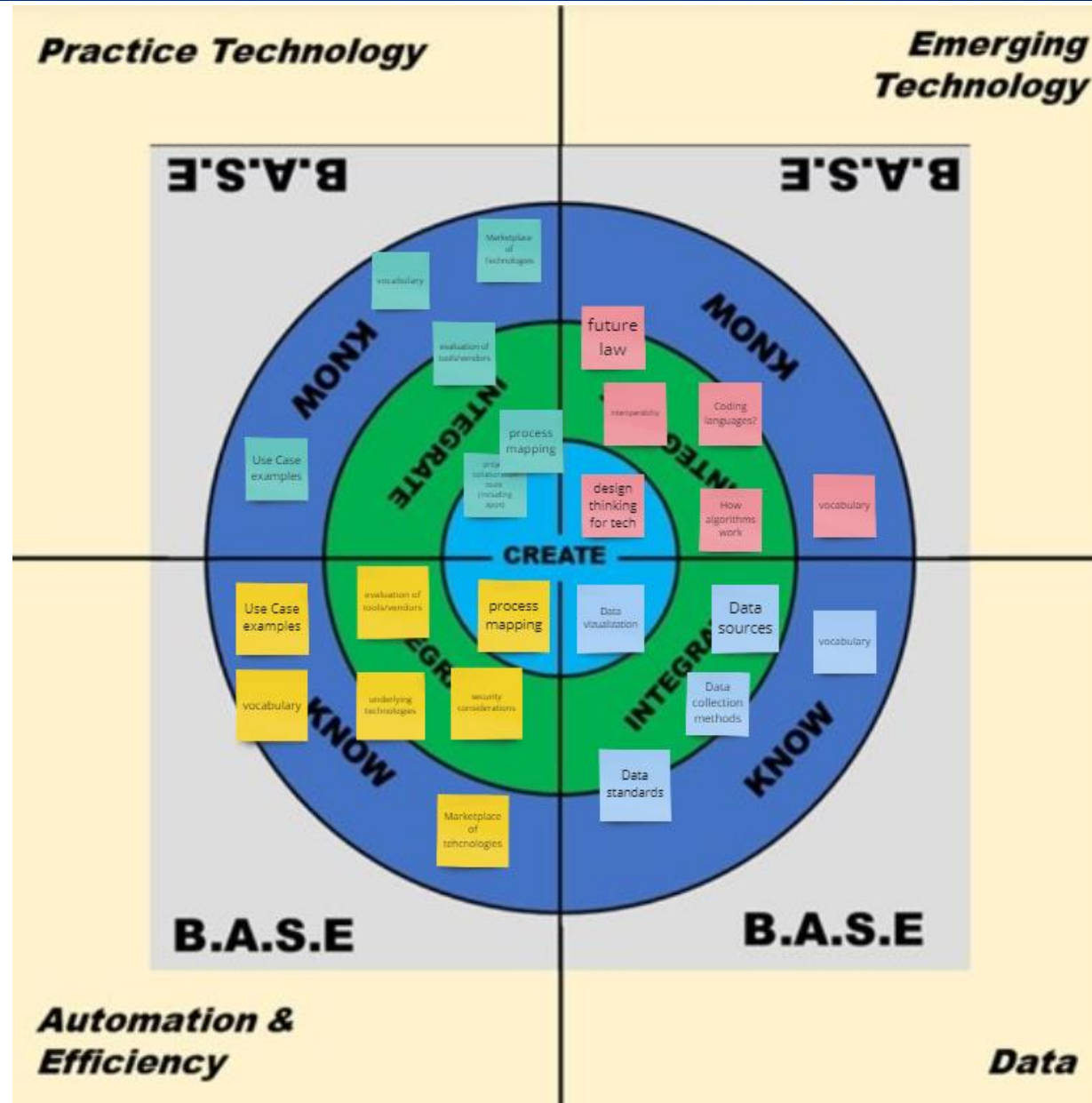


2. Course – Legal Process Engineering

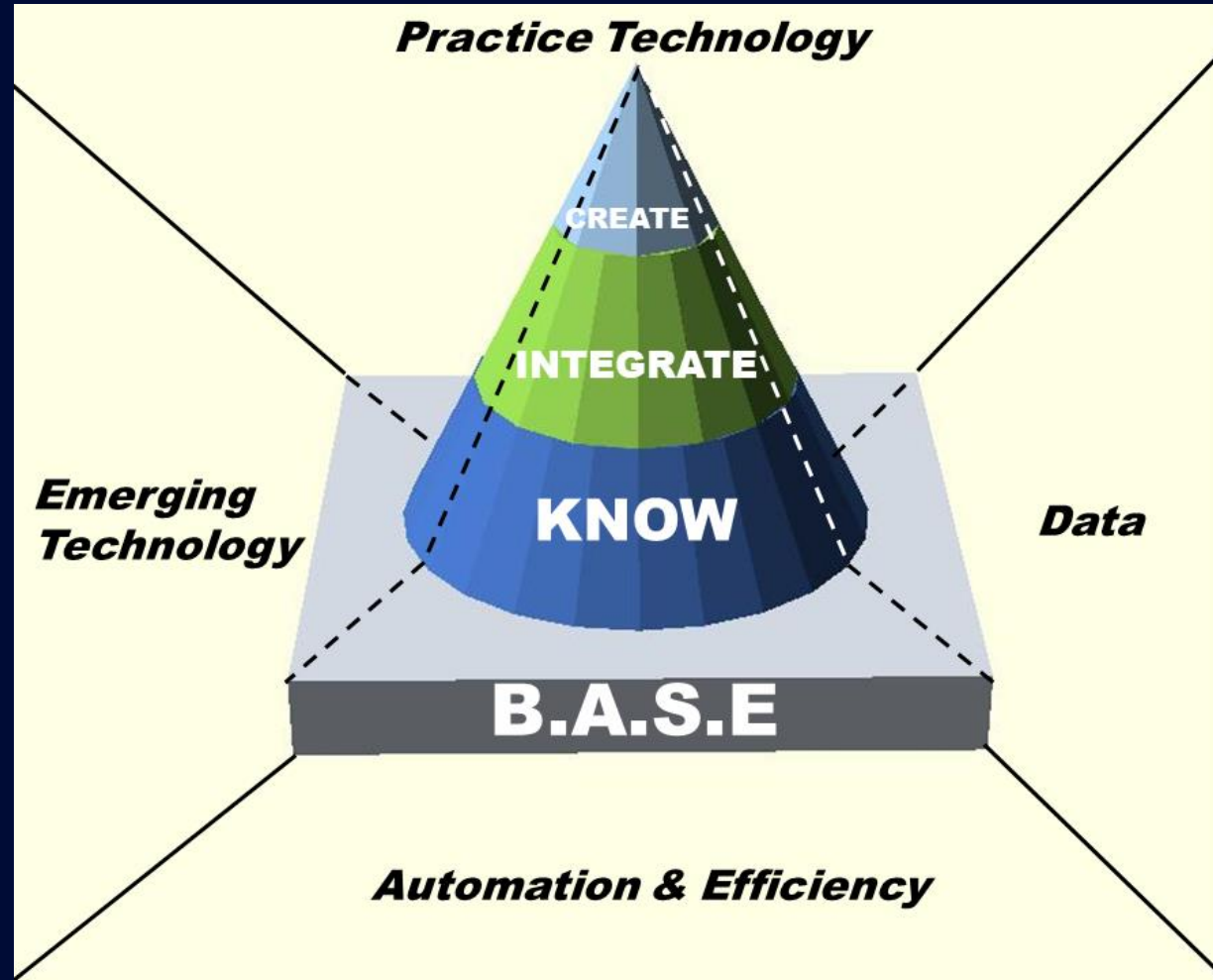
