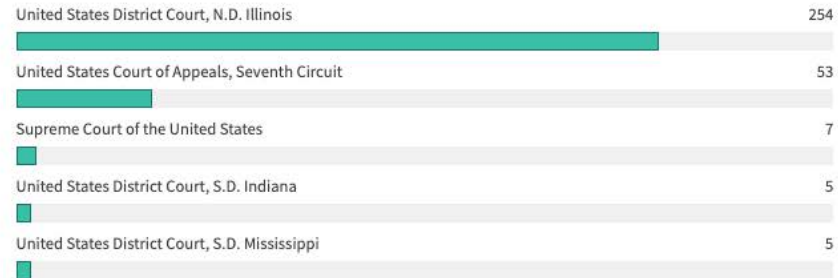

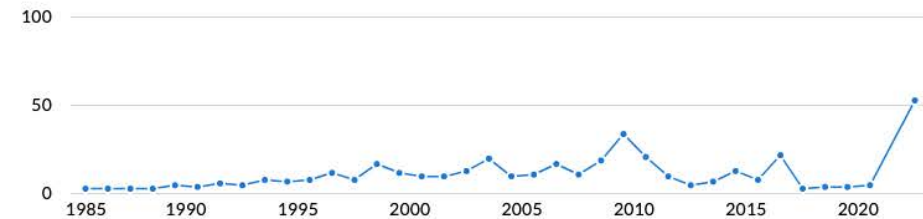

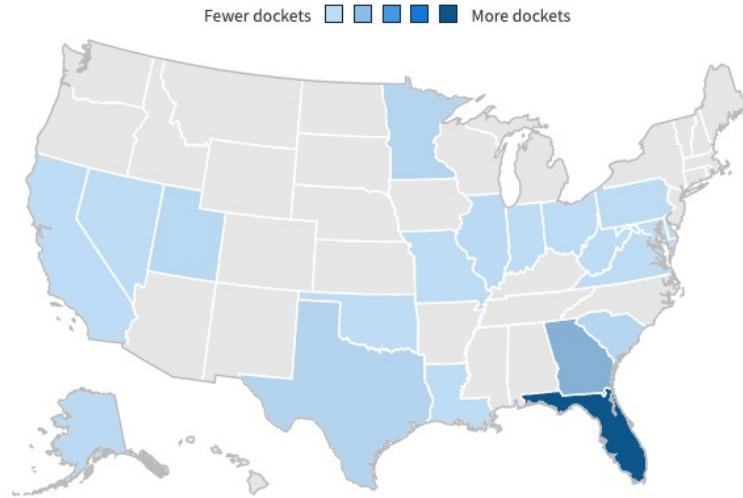

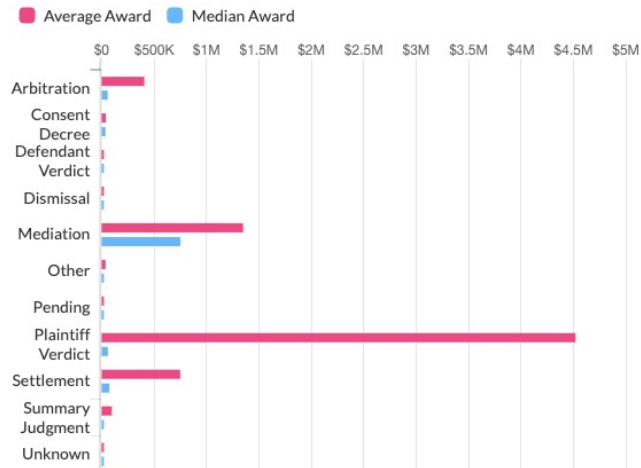

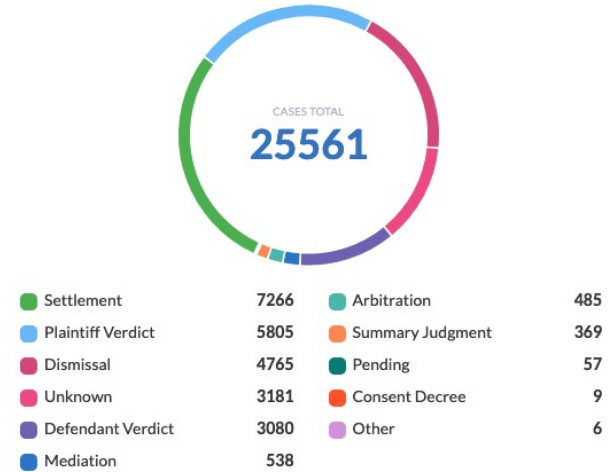

Legal research

I think this type of analytics makes the most sense to attorneys and is closest to the case law research they do. However, it's a way to enhance their research not replace traditional searches.



Business development

It can be good for researching companies – for pitching business it helps to see what a company's litigation history is, and what law firms they've used in the past



Litigation

If case gets reassigned how is this judge different than the one you had.

Research opposing counsel

Look up firms and attorneys to see whom they have represented; history of wins and losses.





Strategy

We want to know how long it typically takes that particular judge to rule on that kind of motion, so we can manage the client's expectations.



Trends

Spotting trends and changes in particular areas of law for strategic planning purposes

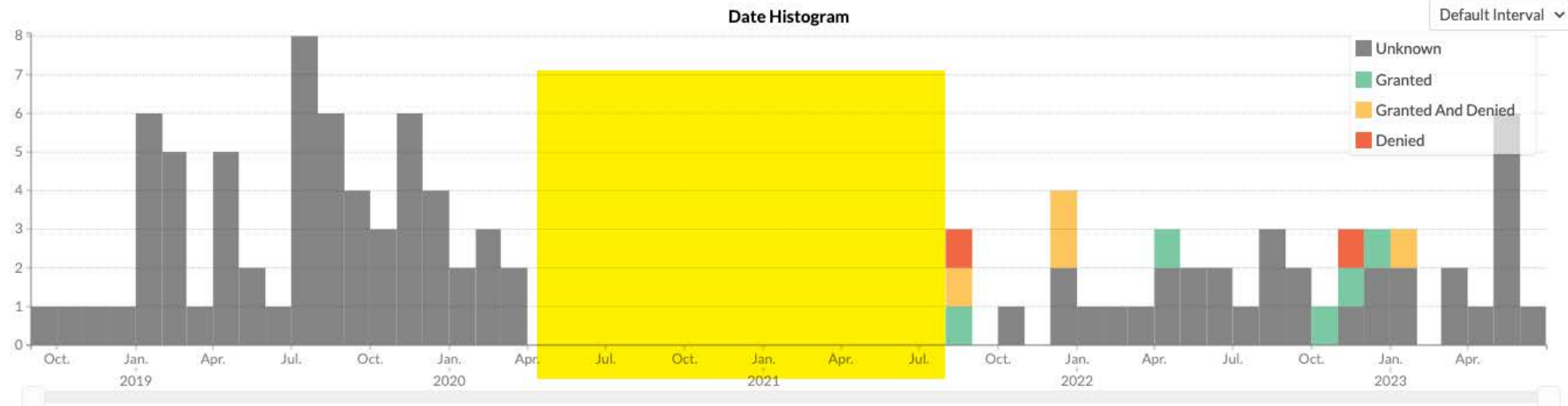

Does it matter?



Hype

Yes, vendors hype the theoretical all the time – they love saying their platforms can help an attorney predict how a judge will rule (though I think they avoid the word “predict” these days).



Data

It's "something" and it gives them the foundation for the story they want to tell a client. In other words, they do not let perfection be the enemy of good.

A rep from Docket Alarm told me that a key issue in analytics development is "defining the grey." I absolutely love this phrase to describe understanding what analytics cannot confidently determine.

At the end of the day a story that includes *some* data is more compelling than a gut reaction (even from a very experienced a lawyer).





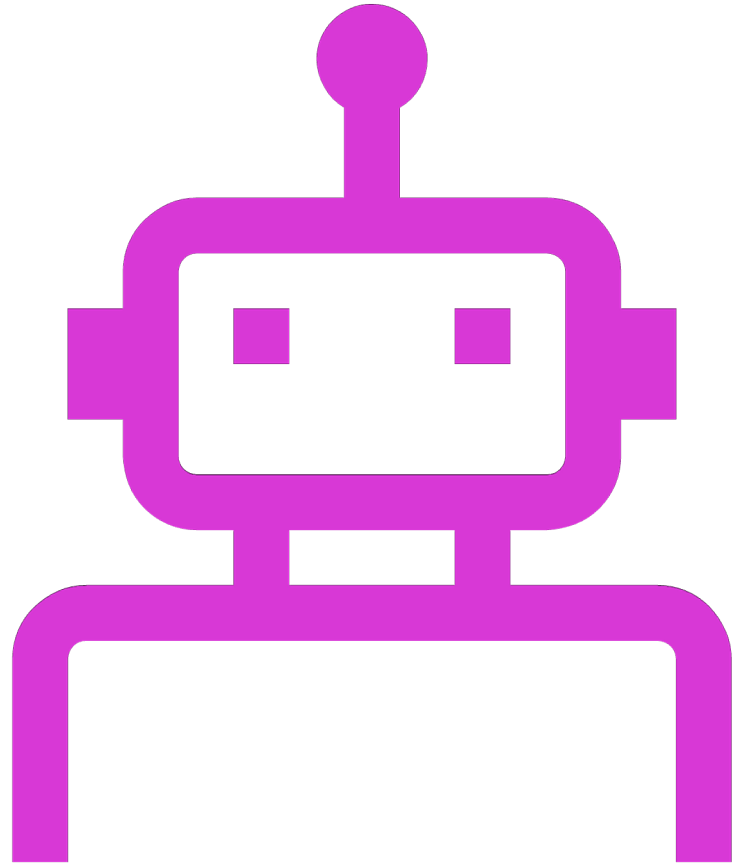

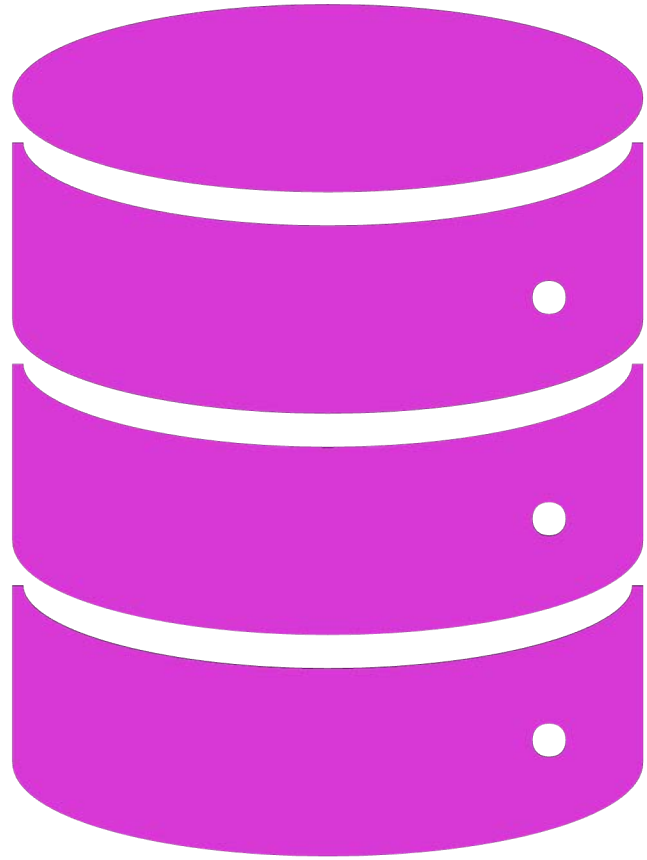

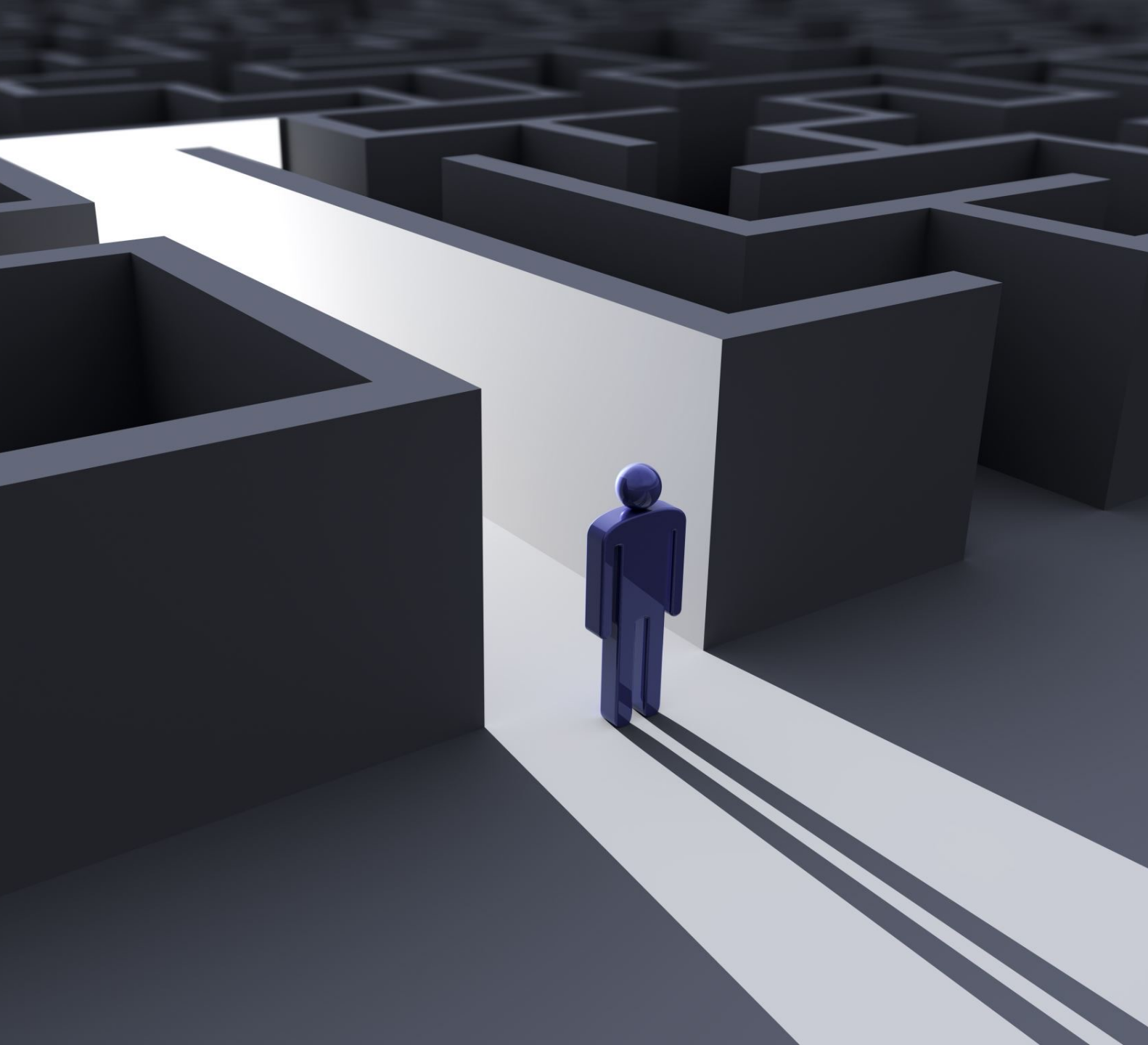
