## Supervised and Reinforcement Learning for Constitutional AI

The authors first explore "supervised learning of CAI" (SL-CAI), where they collect language model responses to prompts designed to elicit harmful responses. The models then critique and revise these responses based on the constitutional principles. The revised responses are used to fine-tune the language models to be more harmless.

The authors then explore "reinforcement learning of CAI" (RL-CAI), where language models generate preference labels for harmlessness to help train a helpful and harmless model through reinforcement learning. They find that RL-CAI models tend to be very harmless according to human evaluations, and unlike previous techniques do not rely on being evasive when discussing sensitive topics.

The CAI techniques enable language models to become more harmless and transparent through self-supervised learning, rather than relying exclusively on human feedback. The authors' results suggest these are promising techniques for developing AI systems that are both helpful and harmless.

The Claude library currently offers 4 different models:

1. `claude-v1-100k` - The default generic summarization model. It was trained on a variety of news articles and general web content. It works well for summarizing most input texts.
2. `claude-law` - A model fine-tuned on a dataset of legal opinions, briefs, and memos. It generates summaries in a style suited for law documents with headings like Issue, Holding, Reasoning, and Disposition.
3. `claude-med` - A model fine-tuned on a large collection of biomedical research papers and clinical trial reports. It produces technical yet concise summaries of medical and life sciences content.
4. `claude-html` - A model that generates HTML string summaries with `<h2>` headings and structured content. The actual summary content is the same as the `claude-v1-100k` model. It just formats the output as an HTML string.
